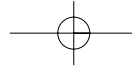

## Itinerary

### Sunday 4th April

Participants arrive at Harris Park, Mt. Panorama in time for Scrutineering by event officials, Festival of Sporting Cars (FoSC).

This will be followed by your accommodation check-in. Time to get to know your new surroundings and time to meet new friends before a driver's briefing and our first evening function, which will be a relaxed Welcome Cocktail Party.

### Monday 5th April

Up bright and early, in time for your very first look at Mt. Panorama.

Experienced FoSC-supplied Bathurst 'Masters' will gently massage your driving skills during a special training session to prepare you for tackling what is regarded as Australia's most iconic, and most challenging, racing circuit. This will be followed by a 35min practice session later in the day.

A Parade Lap for all Club Members is scheduled at lunch time, admittedly at road-legal speeds(!), so everyone attending will have a chance to 'lap' the famous track.

Off the track, Club Members will be participating in a Porsche exclusive Show 'n Shine and a specifically designed Observation Run through the spectacular hills of Bathurst.

For those participants with some spare time, maybe a massage or a relaxed walk through the colonial streetscapes of Bathurst.

As we wine and dine on the best Bathurst has to offer during the evening dinner, everyone has the opportunity to compare notes on the day's activities and ponder on the excitement that will come with the new day.

### Tuesday 6th April

Our non-competitive drivers can choose to watch the track activities or tour the roads of the surrounding Blue Mountains, taking in some of the local highlights. Suggested driving routes will be provided.

For those who have taken the decision to conquer the mountain, all you have learned will be put into practice as you recollect the 6.2 kilometres of twists, turns, straights, rises and dips.

Getting a consistent time is the object of the day... not necessarily out and out speed!

The Six-Hour Relay: Plenty of time on the track. Plenty of time to consult with experienced Bathurst drivers so, with each lap, you can enjoy the experience even more.

You have a chance at an individual Trophy and, along with your team members, a Team Trophy. When all the times are counted, the Club with the most consistent drivers will take home the State Trophy.
