Entries will be accepted in order of receipt, and must be submitted online using the online entry form and payment process on the club's website: www.pcnsw.com.au under "Events". Hard copy Entry Forms will be presented to each Competitor on the day of competition and will require signature as part of the check in process.

19. SCRUTINY - SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS:
Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual are to be worn in **ALL** specials. Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. All cars must be adequately muffled.
- Documents required to be presented will include a CAMS licence, a Club Membership Card and, if issued, a CAMS Vehicle Log Book.

21. TROPHIES: **Refer current Porsche Club NSW Competition Rules**
22. The CAMS permit will be displayed at the start of the event.
23. The organisers may refuse any entry in accordance with NCR 83
24. Entries will be accepted in order of receipt, subject to Item 11 and 12.
25. Entries for drivers under 18 years of age must be counter signed / consented to by a parent / guardian.
26. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au
27. A current CAMS Non-Speed (Level 2NS) Licence or superior is required for each driver.
28. The Organisers may cancel, alter, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59,
29. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual
30. **Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances**
Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
31. **Passengers in Cars**
This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.
- (a) A Briefing must be attended by each Driver and Passenger (and guardians of each Passenger if Passenger is under 18 years of age) conducted by the Clerk of the Course prior to the MSPRA commencing.
- (b) Passengers must:
- Have the permission of the Clerk of Course. The suitability of the Passenger is at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
 - Wear the same protective gear as a Driver in accordance with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
 - Be fitted and restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes.
 - Complete a Passenger Ride Entry Form and disclaimer.
 - Drivers must fill out a Passenger Ride Entry Form to ride as a Passenger.
- (c) Vehicles and Apparel used must pass Scrutiny.
- (d) Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time, unless otherwise approved by CAMS.

32. **Special requirements**

- There will be 4 competitive tests with 2 timed runs each. All timed runs count towards the results. Diagrams of the tests will be given out at Registration.
- Course markers will consist of brightly coloured cones or witches hats
- At the Clerk of the Course's discretion, non-competitive tests may be run before and/or after the competition.
- Drivers and spectators must keep well clear of the competition area at all times. Specifically, drivers must not pull forward into the start garage until called by the start marshal.
- The starting signal will be a hand signal given by the timekeeper. Timing begins when the car leaves the start garage.
