FURTHER SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

“COME AND TRY” AMENDMENTS

PERMIT NUMBER 510/2802/03

REFERENCE SHOULD BE MADE TO THE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

The following clauses have been changed for “Come and Try”.

- 8 Licences: minimum requirement is a CAMS Level 1 Licence for entry to the “Come and Try” section of this Motorkhana.
- 11 Entries Open with publication of these Regulations. Entries close on the day of the event 30 minutes before the end of the scrutineering time as allocated in the suppregs.. Any entries must be made on the official web site as per the suppregs with all relevant details correctly filled out or by the attached Entry Form faxed with payment to the Event Secretary on 08 8364 4431 by 7pm Friday 26th February 2010. Cost \$30 (which includes the cost of a CAMS Level 1 Licence).
- 12 Preference shall be given to entries lodged on the PCSA website up to 7pm, 26th. February 2010
- 13 Maximum Number of Entries to the “Come and Try” section of the event is 15 or as decided by the C of C.

THE FOLLOWING CLAUSES DO NOT APPLY TO “COME AND TRY” ENTRANTS

(These Clauses refer to timing and the competition.)

- 8 There will be two runs per test and the fastest time will be used in the computation of results. (Method of scoring will be explained at the Competitors Briefing).
- 18 Method of Timing: Electronic with Manual backup.
- 19 Results: Published on the PCSA website.
- 21 Penalties: Shall be applied for any infringements as indicated in the National Motorkhana Code (Section 13 of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport); the S.A. Appendix to the NMC; and any further suppregs that may be issued by the Organisers.
- 22 Awards: For each round trophies will be awarded to 1st outright,
